Copenhagen Business School Exchange Program

Copenhagen Business School (CBS) was established in 1917. Today, with 20,000 students including 1,200 exchange students, CBS is one of eight Danish universities and one of the largest business schools in Europe.

Since 2000, CBS has been accredited by EQUIS, and since 2007 also by AMBA. On August 1, 2011, CBS became the first school in Scandinavia to receive an accreditation by AACSB. CBS has thus acquired “The Triple Crown,” an acknowledgement only shared by around 50 business schools worldwide. These schools are reputed as the absolute top business schools and include schools such as INSEAD, London Business School, IMD, and Rotterdam School of Management.

FACILITIES/HOUSING

The CBS campus is an urban campus located in Frederiksberg, an integrated part of Copenhagen. The school buildings are modern with state-of-the-art facilities. The campus is connected to the airport and downtown Copenhagen with four on-campus Metro stops.

CBS will facilitate room renting for exchange students, but students sign a contract with a private landlord. The CBS Housing Department offers a private housing option as a supplement to dorm accommodation only in the fall semester. No private housing facility or assistance is offered in the spring or the summer. Private housing will always include a room with a bed, a desk for studying, internet access, a dresser/closet, and access to a kitchen and bathroom. Rental costs vary depending on your choice of residency.

Fall 2022 semester: August 2022 – Jan. 2023 (Danish Crash Course: August 22- 24)

Spring 2023 semester: January 2023 – June 2023 (Danish Crash Course: January 16-20)

WORKLOAD

Students must take 30 ECTS credits during the exchange semester.
