Frequently Asked Questions

Roundtable Rotation Networking Events

What is a Roundtable event?

Roundtables are our most popular events, attended by a wide range of organizations. Pre-assigned small student groups will rotate every twenty minutes, meeting employer representatives as your assigned table(s).
 Candidates are assigned to rotations based on the student's preferred interest in the roles offered by your organization. The Open Networking Reception at the conclusion provides additional opportunities to meet students not assigned during the formal rotations.

What are the benefits to my organization?

• Due to student popularity, Roundtables are the best way for your organization to generate student interest, making earliest possible connections in the recruiting season. Students will be assigned to your table rotations based on their expressed interest in the roles offered by your firm. You will receive the rotation assignment list along with the student resumes before the event. This interactive format enables employers to attract, engage and expedite continued post-event recruiting efforts with selected candidates.

What do I need to provide to participate?

• Well-written company description, identify the key roles (function descriptions, location, internship or full time) your firm may be interested in recruiting and posted in 12Twenty. This information will be used by the students when they bid on preferred table rotation assignments.

What is the time commitment?

• Approximately 3-4 hours per event. A detailed schedule will be provided at the time of registration confirmation. Companies are permitted to attend multiple Roundtable events.

What is the cost?

• Registration is free. You may also have more than one company representative attend and host additional tables. We provide complimentary parking, meals/refreshments to all guest attendees.

How can Graduate Career Services assist the most successful outcome?

 We can help post your job descriptions, updated company profile information, additional company resources to 12Twenty for broad student visibility. Your relationship manager can further assist you in scheduling additional programming throughout the academic year.

Multi-Employer Virtual Talent Connections

What is a multi-employer Virtual Talent Connections event?

• Talent Connections will give you the opportunity to meet students through one-on-one virtual sessions, like a coffee chat format. You will have the opportunity to choose the graduate program to target your internship or fall-time recruiting. You may choose MBA-only, Masters only or both.

Do students pre-register for each session?

• During this event, company schedules will be available to students to select specific session times based on employer preference to meet students one-on-one for 15-minute timed sessions.

Can you help with setting up our schedule?

• Yes, a member of our employer relations team will work with each firm to set-up the "coffee-chat" schedules based on the number of "rooms" you wish to host.
